Quel pronom ?	ex
<i>Which</i> ou <i>that</i> quand l'antécédent est non-humain	Biopics are films. Biopics are based on the lives of real people. → Biopics are films which/that are based on the lives of real people.
<i>Who</i> ou <i>that</i> quand l'antécédent est humain	This film is about Odysseus. Odysseus was a hero of the Greek mythology. → This film is about Odysseus who was a hero of the Greek mythology.
<i>Whose</i> pour marquer la possession	This article is about an artist. This artist's idea became viral on social media. → This article is about an artist whose idea became viral on social media.
<i>O</i> / <i>that</i> quand le pronom a la fonction de COD du verbe.	I saw a film yesterday. The film I saw is a romance. → The film I saw is a romance.
<i>Where</i> pour parler d'un lieu	I'm going to the beach. I met my husband at this beach. → I going to the beach where I met my husband.
